
### Māori engaging with Māori Layers of connection

Maunga, awa, waka, iwi, hapū, marae, whānau, pā, church, kōhanga, kura, taiao, hākinakina, cultural, tangi

#### **LAYERS OF CONNECTION - Internal**

Level of Māori society	Areas of activity and interest	Scale (e.g. for decision-making, co-management)	Main representation (constituents)
lwi	Highest level governance (political, Treaty claims, tribal assets, regional entities, iwi authorities)	Regional-national (large geographic areas, tribal boundaries)	Representation by iwi, hapū, marae, and whānau
Hapū	District-hapū development, local politics & decision- making, hapū and whānau values	District (small territorial areas, e.g. river-lake catchment areas, based on local geography or hapū boundaries)	Strong representation by whānau and marae
Marae	Social and cultural development: sites, districts, catchments	Location-based, specific sites	Strong representation by local hapū and whānau (e.g. ahi kaa*)
Whānau	Human, social, cultural and economic capital within families	Both local and dispersed throughout NZ and overseas ( <i>e.g.</i> Australia)	Extended families, individuals
