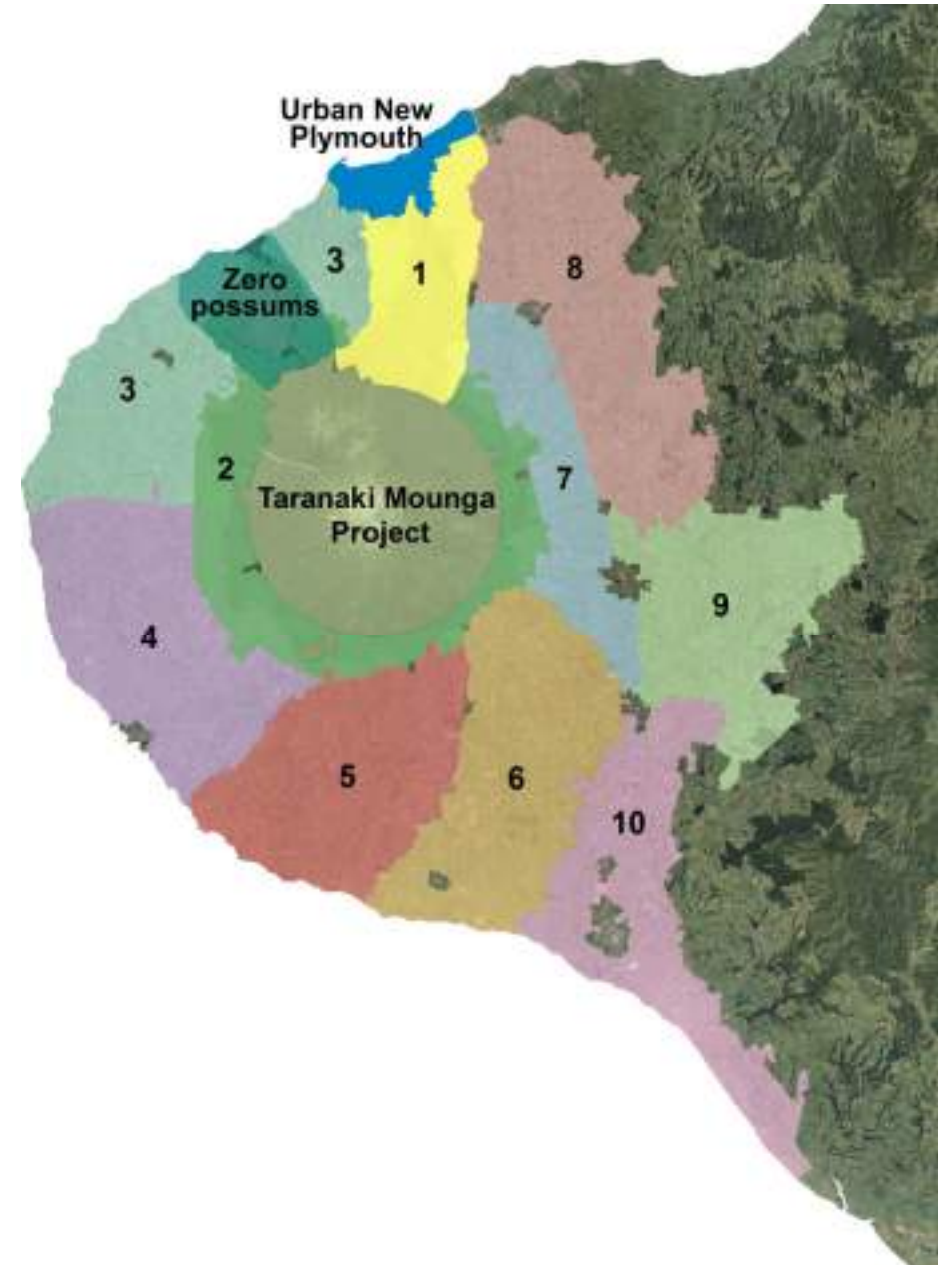


Taking Taranaki forward



Project Overview

- Direct link to objective 4 of TMPL.
- 10 year project.
- Rolled out in stages starting with Waiwhakaiho and Kaitake.
- 700,000ha of the Taranaki ring plain.
- Targeting possums, mustelids and site specific rat control (in Key Native Ecosystems).
- Outcomes:
 - Increased biodiversity where people live and play.
 - Community connectivity and normalising restoration behaviour.
 - Health and economic benefits realised from predator control.
 - Supporting other initiatives in the region.

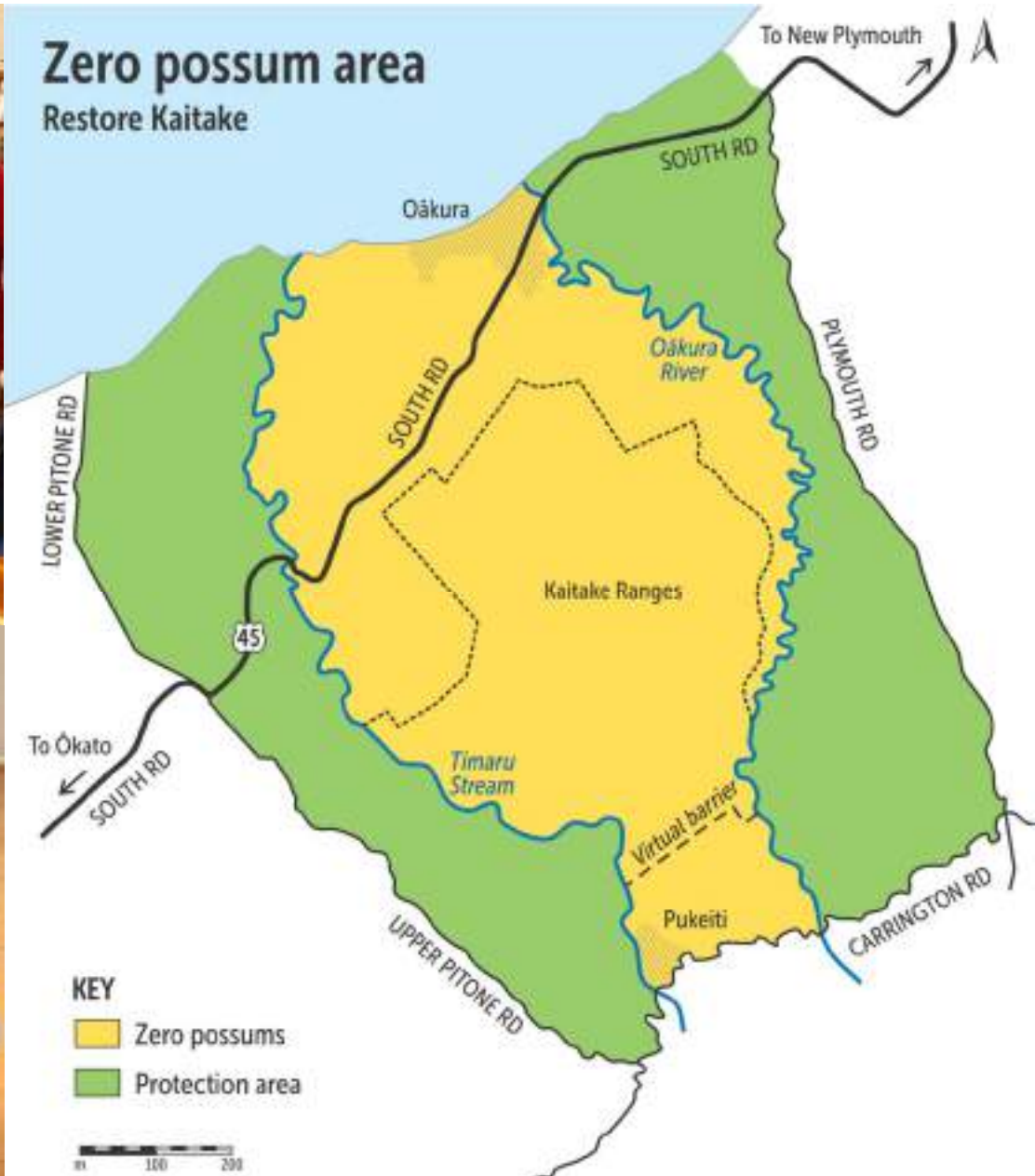
